<p><b>Background of PPSG Money:</b> The government has provided additional funding of £150 million per annum to improve the provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - has been allocated to primary school head teachers. This funding is ring-fenced and can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.</p>
