COVID UPDATES

We are always reviewing our Covid19 procedures and there are a few reminders that we need to give.

Hand Sanitiser ... Please can all families make sure that the children do not bring in any of their own hand sanitiser. We have plenty in school that is freely available and frequently used. In school we have to adhere to 'Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH) Regulations' and if children bring in their own we cannot do that. They are also not using it in a safe way because they often share bottles.

Items from Home ... Please can all families make sure that the children are not bringing in toys, jewellery or gifts for others from home as they are swapping these and also things are going missing. However, our biggest concern is with all things that come from home we leave them to fallow for two days, but when children bring in these things they are simply being handed from family to family, putting people at risk.

Temperature Checks ... The guidance remains the same and it states that temperature checks should not be carried out in schools or nurseries as they provide an unreliable form of data. We temperature check children who are off colour as per the guidance, but not everyone, every morning.
