Re: School Fund Contribution 2020-21

At Brook Infant School we offer a stimulating, connected and enriched curriculum. Artists, performers, experts and special events ensure we deepen the children's interest and enthusiasm for learning alongside their knowledge and understanding. We aim to offer the opportunity for each child to experience a live performance, musical or artistic professional input and special events, as well as days related to the class topic. Last year, children in Year Two benefited from subsidised weekly swimming lessons, the whole school had a subsidised trip to the Pantomime at the Hawth, Year One children had a subsidised visit to Hever Castle, the whole school and nursery experienced a professional Opera Performance, Year One and Two had subsidised music lessons and there were classroom resources for our many learning themes along with books for our library. We try to spend this limited pot as efficiently as possible to provide a balance between lovely experiences for the children as well as giving parents value for money.

To help fund all experiences, events and trips, we ask for a £10 voluntary contribution per child for the whole year. By charging this specified sum for the year rather than individual amounts, it not only cuts down on administration costs, but also means that we don't have to keep sending out letters requesting small amounts of money. This amount does not include top ups for school trips, which will be charged for separately.
